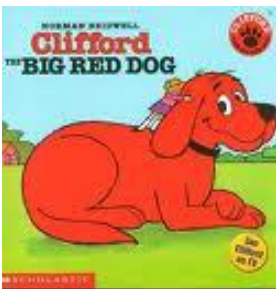


Bears New Friend by Karma Wilson

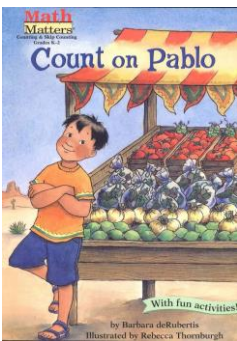


Clifford The Big Red Dog by Norman Bridwell

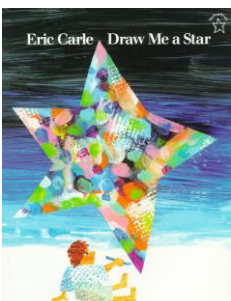


Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus! by Mo Willems

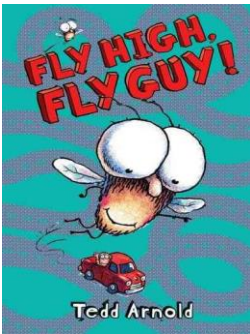


Draw Me a Star by Eric Carle

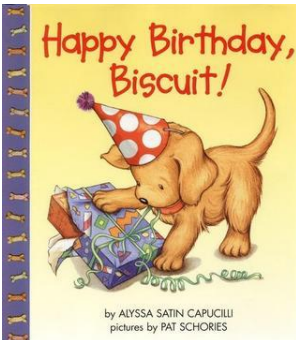


Fly High, Fly Guy! by Tedd Arnold

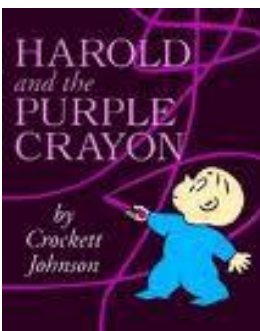


Happy Birthday, Biscuit! by Pat Schories

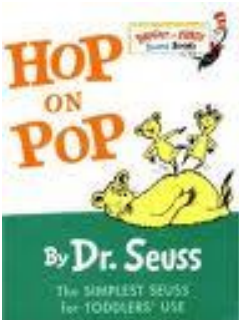


Harold and the Purple Crayon by Crockett Johnson

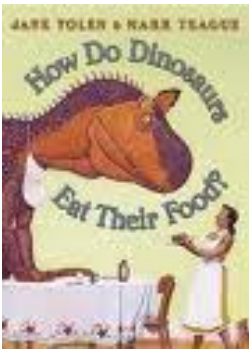


Hot Rod Hamster by Cynthia Lord

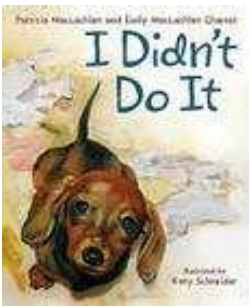


How Do Dinosaurs Eat Their Food? by Jane Yolen

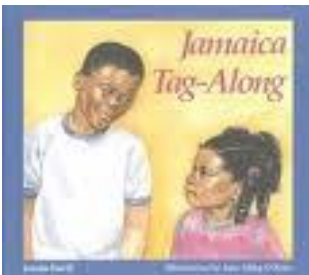


I Didn't Do It by Patricia & Emily MacLachlan

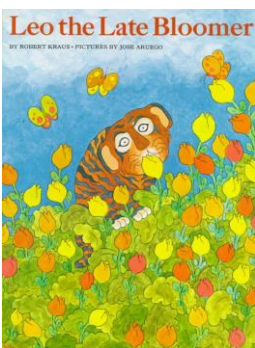


***Jamaica Tag-Along** by Juanita Havill

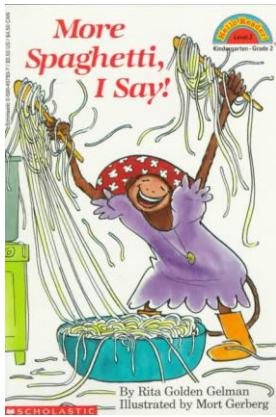


Leo the Late Bloomer by Robert Kraus

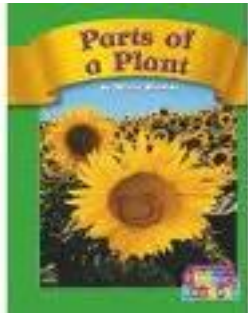


More Spaghetti, I Say! by Rita Golden Gelman

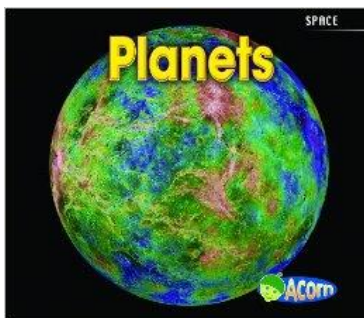


***Pet Show!** By Ezra Jack Keats

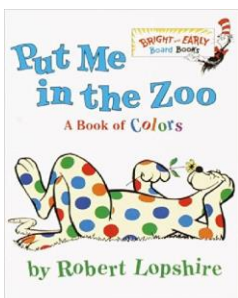


****Planets** by Charlotte Guillain

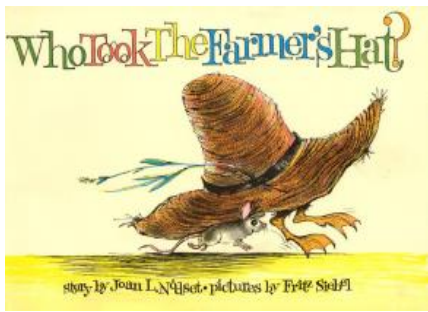


Put Me in the Zoo by Robert Lopshire

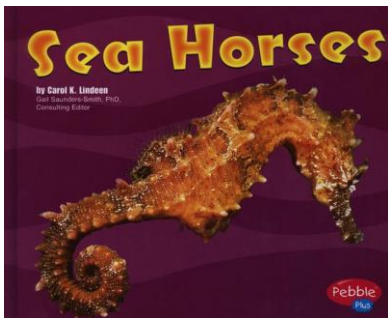
A large, spotted animal discovers he really belongs in a circus, not a zoo.
