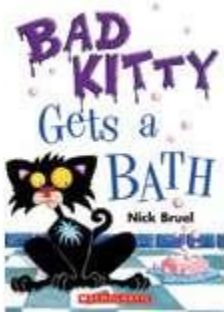


***The Babe and I** by David A. Adler

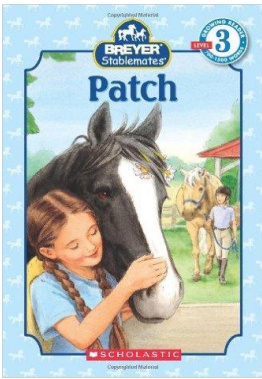


Bad Kitty Gets a Bath by Nick Bruel

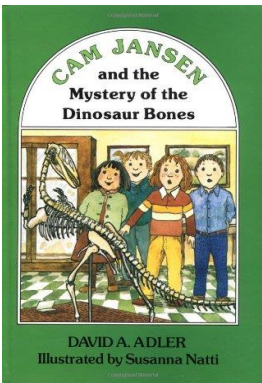


Breyer Stablemates (series) by Elizabeth J. Mills,

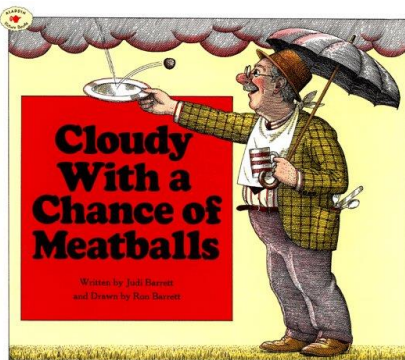


Cam Jansen (series) by David Adler

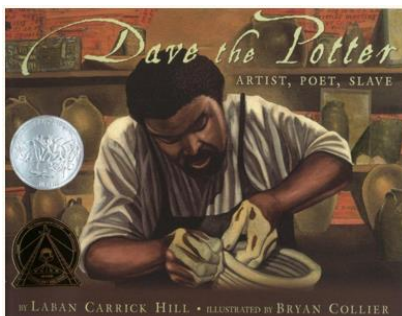


Cloudy With a Chance of Meatballs by Judi Barrett

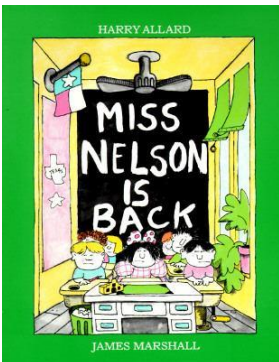


Madeline (series) by Ludwig Bemelmans

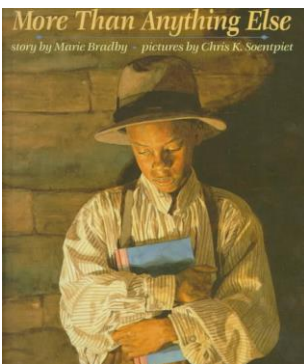


Miss Nelson is Back (series) by Harry Allard

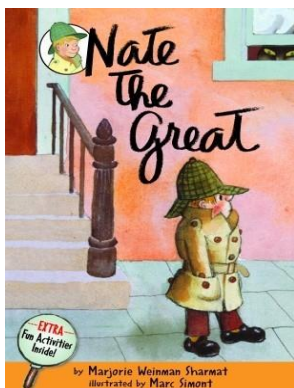


***More Than Anything Else** by Marie Bradby

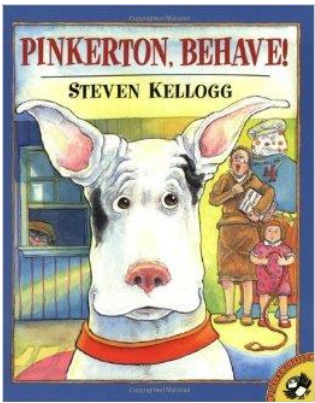


Nate the Great (series) by Marjorie Weinman Sharmat

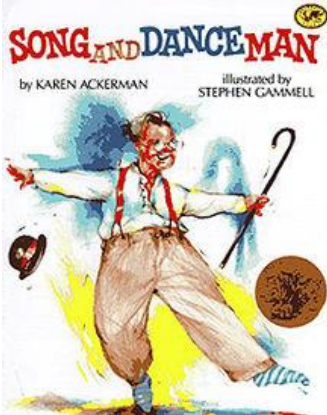


Pinkerton, Behave! by Steven Kellogg

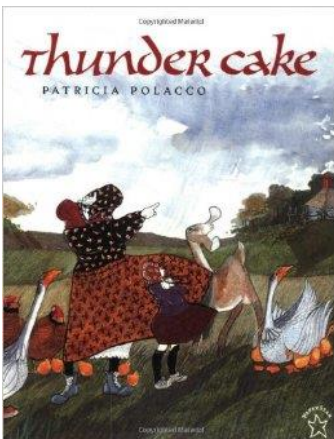


Song and Dance Man by Karen Ackerman

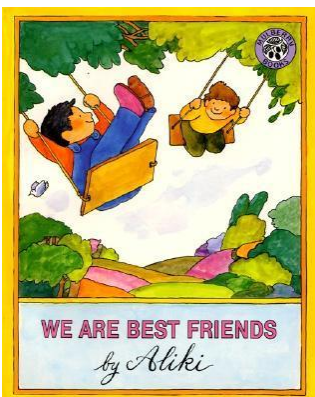


Thunder Cake by Patricia Polacco

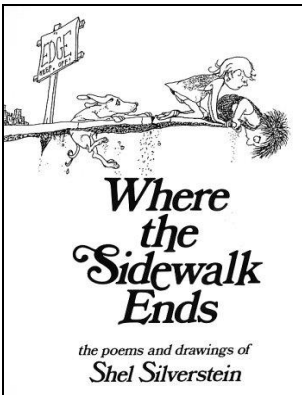


We Are Best Friends by Aliko

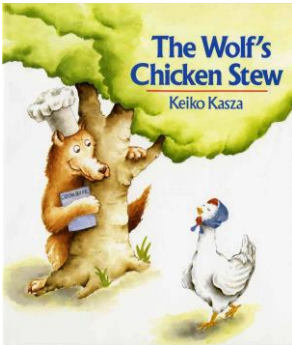


Where the Sidewalk Ends by Shel Silverstein

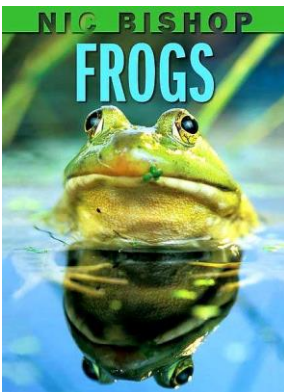


The Wolf's Chicken Stew by Keiko Kasza
