



***Do Unto Otters: A Book About Manners*** by Laurie Keller


***Frog and Toad Are Friends*** (series) by Arnold Lobel

Be entertained by the classic, short, delightful tales about best friends Frog and Toad. *Series*




***Once I Ate a Pie*** by Patricia and Emily MacLachlan

Fourteen free-verse poems and beautiful oil paintings capture the personality of each dog in these examples of a dog's life from the perspective of the animals.




***Amelia Bedelia Means Business*** (series) by Herman Parish or Peggy Parish


**Henry and Mudge and the Big Sleepover** (series) by Cynthia Rylant


**Nate the Great and the Hungry Book Club** (series) by Marjorie Weinman Sharmat and Mitchell Sharmat
