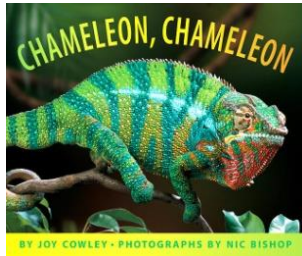
Bears New Friend

Bear and his friends persuade a bashful owl to play with them. The rhyme and the warm illustrations are lively.



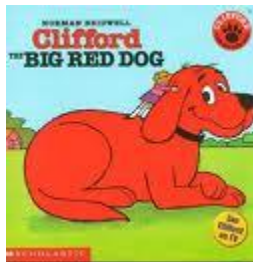
****Chameleon, Chameleon**

A colorful chameleon encounters friend and foe while making his way from one tree to another in search of a tasty insect dinner.



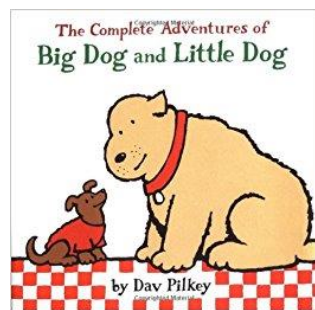
Clifford The Big Red Dog

Emily Elizabeth describes the activities she enjoys with her very big, very red dog and how they take care of each other.



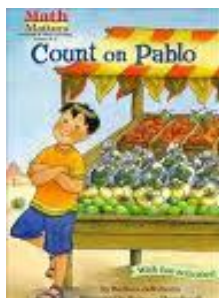
**The Complete Adventures of Big Dog

Pablo demonstrates how good he is at counting while helping his grandmother, his "abuela," prepare to sell vegetables at the market.



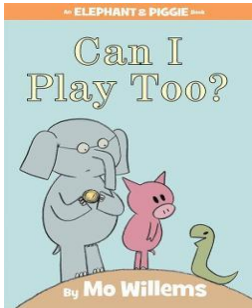
Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus!

Features two friends: an elephant, Gerald, and a pig, Piggie. The books are written in conversational style. The books often address issues of friendship.



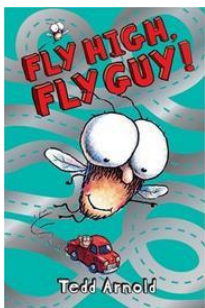
Fix This Mess

Robug tries to obey when Jake instructs it to "Fix this mess!" but somehow manages to make things worse.



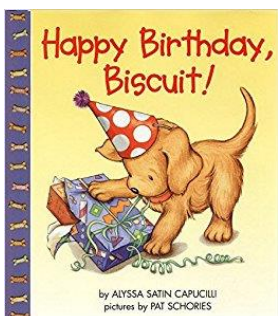
Fly High, Fly Guy!

When Buzz, his parents, and his pet fly go on a road trip and get lost, Fly Guy comes to the rescue to help them find their way home.



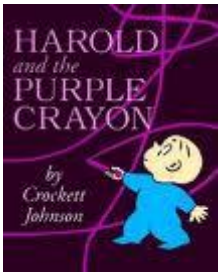
Happy Birthday, Biscuit!

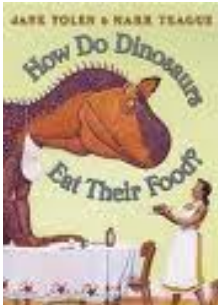
Harold and the Purple Crayon

Harold uses his fantastic purple crayon to draw himself some wonderful adventures.



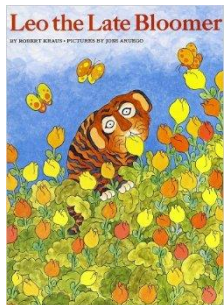
How Do Dinosaurs Eat Their Food?

Presents an introduction to table manners, in simple text with illustrations, explaining proper etiquette as a variety of dinosaurs display playful antics at the dinner table.



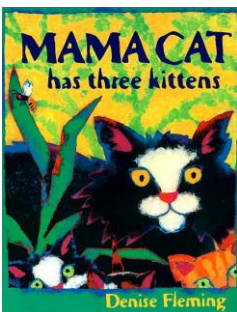
Leo the Late Bloomer

Antic illustrations add a comic edge to a sweetly reassuring tale about a tiger cub who eventually catches up to his more accomplished animal friends



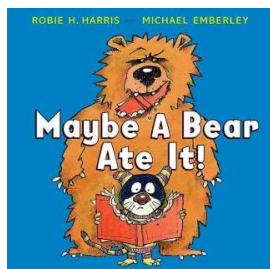
Mama Cat Has Three Kittens
