



CIR-2, Library Cards for Residents of Non-Member Communities / Paid Cards

Policy Statement - The Camden County Library System offers residents who live in non-member communities and those who live outside Camden County access to collections and services at a cost that is comparable to what residents in member communities pay for those services.

Regulations

1. Residents of non-member communities and those who reside outside of Camden County may purchase a library card at the following rates:
 - 1.1 Three-month card - \$25.00 per household
 - 1.2 Six-month card - \$50.00 per household
 - 1.3 One-year card - \$85.00 per household
 - 1.4 One year card--Senior citizens (age 65 and over) who reside outside of Camden County- \$20.00 per person
2. Adults (age 18 and older) and juveniles (ages 15 through 17) must present a valid photo identification card with current street address or two other items of identification with current street address. If US Mail is being used as a form of ID, it must be issued or postmarked within the last 90 days and include name and current address. If unable to provide such identification, the registration may be processed, and the card mailed to a street address. In this case, materials may not be borrowed until the card is received in the mail.
3. The Library Director is authorized to issue paid library cards for free or at reduced rates during Library sponsored special promotions, programs, or initiatives.
