Divorce in New Jersey

Getting a divorce in New Jersey can be complicated. We can help you get started with the following resources.

- Divorce in New Jersey: A Self-Help Guide published by the Legal Services of New Jersey. This guide has instructions and legal forms that you can copy. It is available at most branches. You will need to provide ID to use a reference copy, which must stay in the branch. There may also be a circulating copy available that you can place a hold on to borrow for up to 3 weeks.
- Legal Services of New Jersey (LSNJ) is an organization that provides free legal
 assistance and information to individuals with low income. You can find the
 instructions from their *Divorce in New Jersey* book on their website,
 www.lsnj.org. Click on Publications and then Divorce in New Jersey. The
 forms are not available online; they must be copied from the book. You can
 either purchase the full book with forms from LSNJ or use the library's copy.
