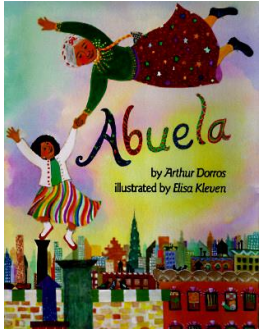

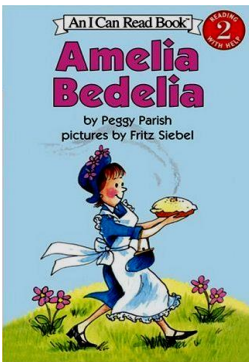


***Abuela** by Arthur Dorros

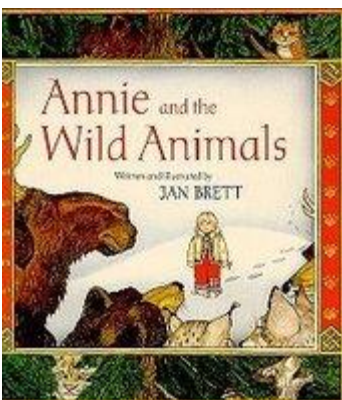


***Whistle for Willie** by Ezra Jack Keats

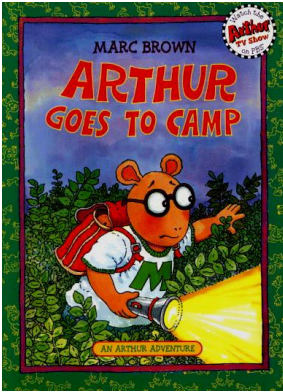


Annie and the Wild Animals by Jan Brett

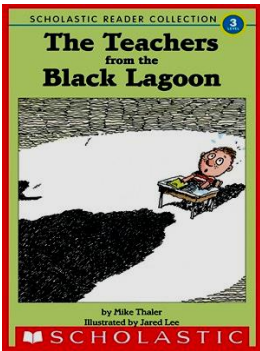

Arthur is not looking forward to Camp Meadowcroak, and when mysterious things start happening there, he decides to run away.

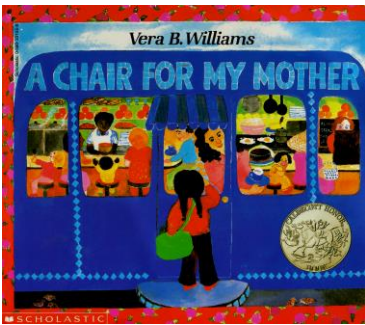

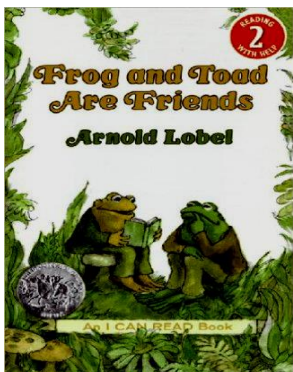

A child, her waitress mother, and her grandmother save dimes to buy a comfortable armchair after all their furniture is lost in a fire.

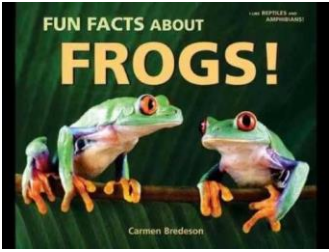

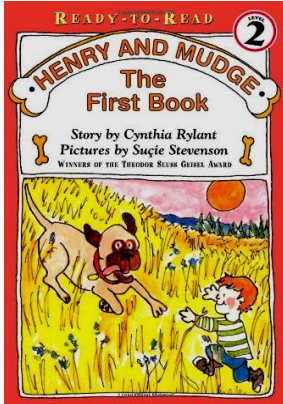


****Fun Facts About Frogs!** by Carmen Bredeson

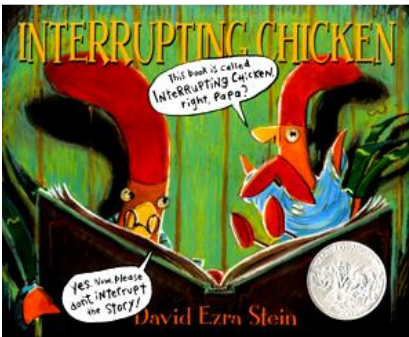


Henry and Mudge (series) by Cynthia Rylant

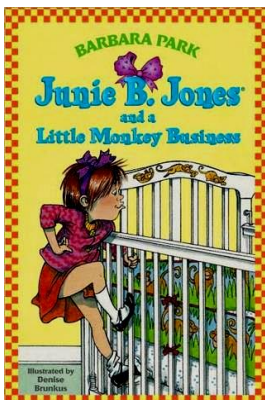


Interrupting Chicken by David Ezra Stein

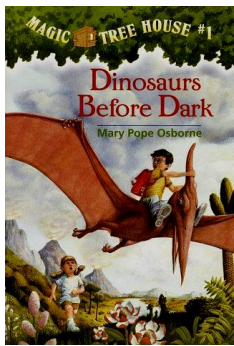


Junie B. Jones (series) by Barbara Park

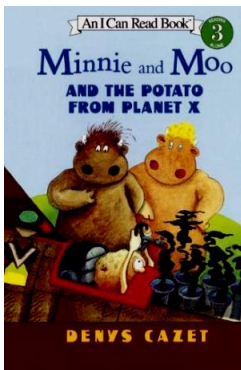

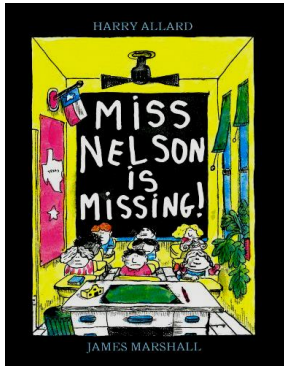


Minnie and Moo (series) by Denys Cazet

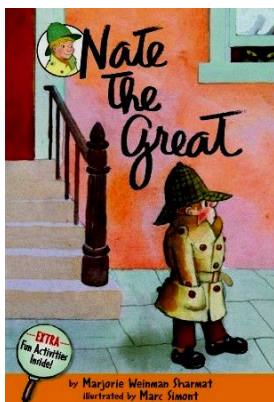


Miss Nelson is Missing by Harry Allard

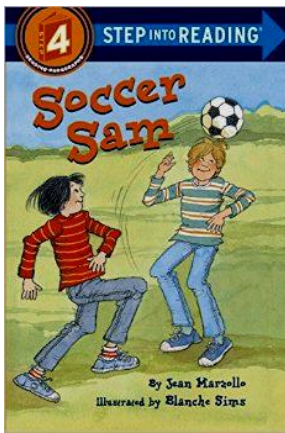


Nate the Great by Margorie W. Sharmat

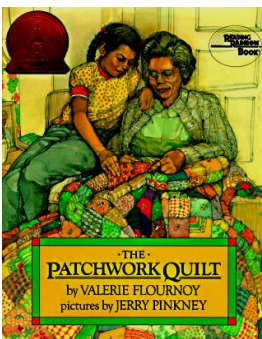


***Soccer Sam** by Jean Marzollo

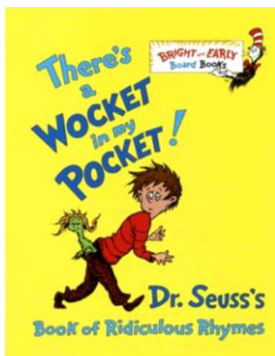


***The Patchwork Quilt** by Valerie Flournoy

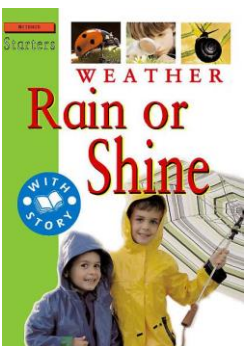


There's a Wocket in My Pocket by Dr. Seuss

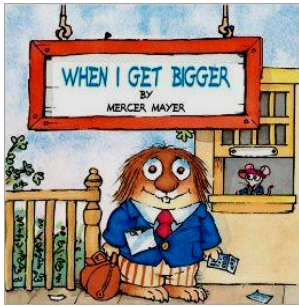


****Weather: Rain or Shine** by Jim Pipe

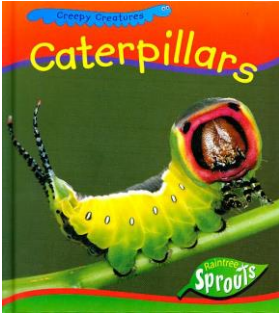


When I Get Bigger by Mercer Mayer

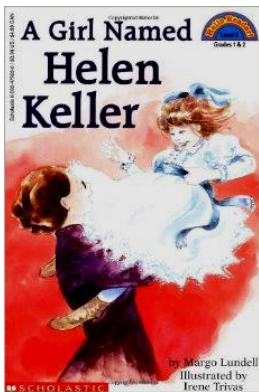


****Caterpillars** by Sarah Chappelow
