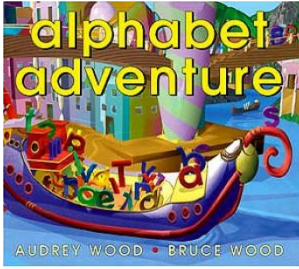


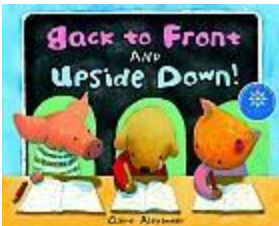

Interest Level: K-3

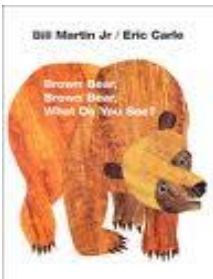
On their way to school, the little letters of the alphabet have to rescue little "i" and then find his dot before they can proceed.

Interest Level: K-3

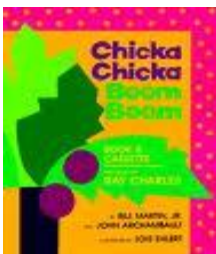
While the rest of the class makes birthday cards for the principal, Stanley struggles with his words and letters.

Interest Level: K-3

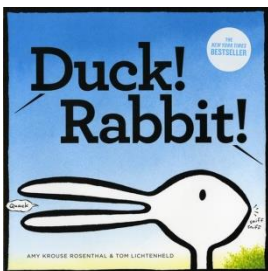
Children see a variety of animals, each one a different color, and a teacher looking at them.

Interest Level: K-3

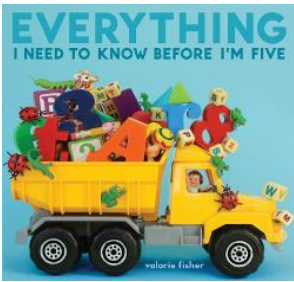
An alphabet rhyme/chant that relates what happens when the whole alphabet tries to climb a coconut tree.

A picture book designed to help children learn the basic concepts they need to know before starting kindergarten, including numbers, letters, colors, shapes, opposites, and seasons.

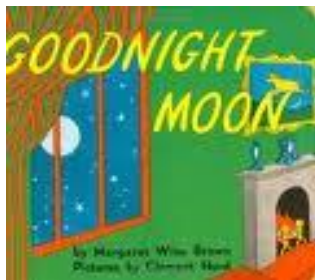


***Freight Train**

Brief text and illustrations trace the journey of a colorful train as it goes through tunnels, by cities, and over trestles.

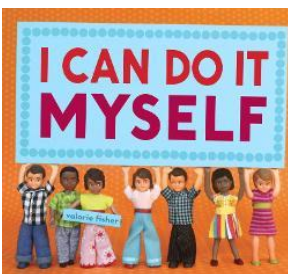


Goodnight Moon

A little bunny says goodnight to each of the objects in the great green room before falling asleep.

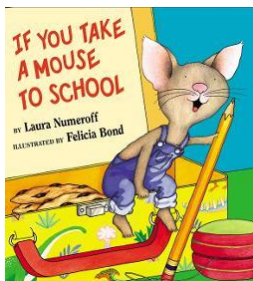


I Can Do It Myself

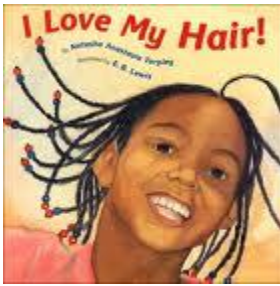


If You Take a Mouse to School

Describes the mountain of mischief a mouse could get into--in science class, reading class, and playtime, for example--if he came along to school.

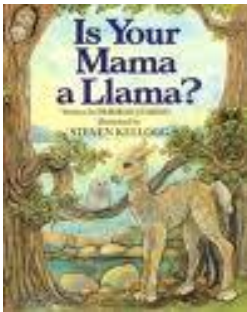


***I Love My Hair!**

A young African-American girl describes the different, wonderful ways she can wear her hair.

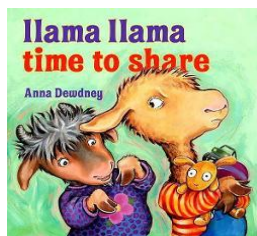


Is Your Mama a Llama?

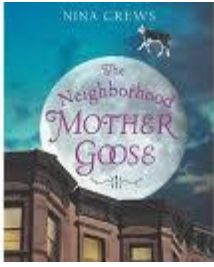


My Five Senses

Interest Level: K-3

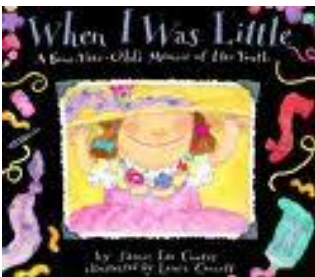
As darkness falls, animal and human parents everywhere try to get their children ready for sleep.
